Roles and responsibilities:

- Evaluate the patients for occupational therapy and perform comprehensive assessment of the children with special needs.
- Provide guidance on the independent living skills and basic ADL activities.
- Should communicate with patients on the clinical conditions and discuss on the further management options.
- Assessment of children and devise training plan.
- Provide training plan and re-assessment plan for patients for their therapy.
- Appropriate referral to other specialty as and when needed.
- Able to assist patients from out station and guide them for appropriate training.
- Maintain professionalism with patients, their attendants and colleagues
- Coordinate with Optometry department / rehabilitation specialists for patient care pertaining to the low vision care and vision enhancement.
- Coordinate with the consultants for the further management of patients.
- Coordinate with patient services department for clinical services.
- Teaching / training Bachelors and fellowship students of Optometry.
- Follow protocols in the department and maintain records for the same.
- Be pro-active for the development of the department and appraise the HOD about day today activities on patient care.
